2. These bid documents do not constitute an agreement; its sole purpose is to provide interested bidders with information that may be useful to them in preparing their bids pursuant to these bid documents. These bid documents may not be appropriate for all persons and it's not possible for PCP to consider the objectives and particular needs of each party which reads or uses these bid documents. The assumption, assessment, statements and information contained in theses bid documents may not be complete, accurate and adequate or correct for the purposes of any or all bidders. 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PART- I

SECTION-I

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

A. INTRODUCTION

Scope of Bid

- 1.1 Paraplegic Center Peshawar, invites bids through EPADS for supply of Goods specified in the Schedule of Requirements along with Technical Specifications and related services incidental thereto to meet the requirement of KPPRA, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with Bid Reference Number for the procurement activity as mentioned in Bid Data Sheet (BDS).

1. SOURCE OF FUNDS

- 1.1 Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) as mentioned in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS).

2. ELIGIBLE BIDDERS

- 2.1 This Invitation for Bids is open to all suppliers, except as provided hereinafter.
- 2.2 Bidders should not be associated, or have been associated in the past, directly or indirectly, with a firm or any of its affiliates which have been engaged by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) to provide consulting services for the preparation of the design, specifications, and other documents to be used for the procurement of the goods to be purchased under this Invitation for Bids.
- 2.3 Government-owned enterprises may participate only if they are legally and financially autonomous, if they operate under commercial law, and if they are not a dependent agency of the Government.
- 2.4 Bidders shall not be under a declaration of blacklisting by any Government department or Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Procurement Regulatory Authority or involved in any corrupt practice or facing such case anywhere.

3. ELIGIBLE GOODS AND SERVICES

- 3.1 All goods and related services to be supplied under the contract shall have their origin in eligible source countries, and all expenditures made under the contract will be limited to such goods and services.
- 3.2 For purposes of this clause, "origin" means the place where the goods are mined, grown, or produced, or the place from which the related services are supplied. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing, or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially-recognized product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.

4. COST OF BIDDING

- 4.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid, and the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

B. THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

5. CONTENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

5.1 The goods required, bidding procedures, and contract terms are prescribed in the bidding documents. In addition to the Invitation for Bids, the bidding documents include:

- a. Instructions to Bidders (ITB);
- b. Bid Data Sheet;
- c. Schedule of Requirements;
- d. Technical Specifications;
- e. Bid Submission Form;
- f. Manufacturer's Authorization Form;
- g. Price Schedules;
- h. Contract Form;
- i. Performance Security Form;
- j. General Conditions of Contract (GCC);
- k. Specification & Design if any;
- l. Delivery time or completion time/schedule;
- m. Bid evaluation Criteria;
- n. Any other / subsequent from if any;

5.2 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the bidding documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or to submit a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of its bid.

6. CLARIFICATION OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

6.1 A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the bidding documents may notify the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in writing or by email at the Paraplegic Center Peshawar address before a week to the closing date of the bids or as per decision of PCP.

7. AMENDMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS

7.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, may modify the bidding documents by amendment. All prospective bidders that have received the bidding documents will be notified of the amendment in writing or by email, and will be bidding on them.

7.3 In order to allow prospective bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their bids, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

8. LANGUAGE OF BID

- 8.1 The bid prepared by the Bidder, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) shall be written in English language specified in the Bid Data Sheet.
- 8.2 In case of any other language, the authentic copy of the translation & translated document should be enclosed and in case of any ambiguity the true contract / copy should be provided.

9. DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE BID

- 9.1 The bid prepared by the Bidder shall comprise the following components:
 - (a) A Bid Form and a Price Schedule completed in accordance with ITB Clauses 10, 11, and 12;
 - (b) Documentary evidence established in accordance with ITB Clause 13 that the Bidder is eligible to bid and is qualified to perform the contract if its bid is accepted;
 - (c) Documentary evidence established in accordance with ITB Clause 14 that the goods and ancillary services to be supplied by the Bidder are eligible goods and services and conform to the bidding documents; and
 - (d) Bid security furnished in accordance with ITB Clause 15 or any other information required by PCP.

10. BID FORM

- 10.1 The Bidder shall complete the Bid Form and the appropriate Price Schedule furnished in the bidding documents, indicating the goods to be supplied, a brief description of the goods, and their country of origin, quantity, and prices.

11. BID PRICES

- 11.1 The Bidder shall indicate on the appropriate Price Schedule the unit prices (where applicable) and total bid price of the goods it proposes to supply under the contract.
- 11.2 Prices quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account, unless otherwise specified in the Bid Data Sheet. A bid submitted with an **adjustable price / Optional quotation** will be treated as nonresponsive and will be rejected.

12. BID CURRENCIES

- 12.1 Prices shall be quoted in **Pak Rupees** unless otherwise specified in the Bid Data Sheet.

13. DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING BIDDER'S ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATION

- 13.1 Pursuant to ITB Clause 9, the Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the Bidder's eligibility to bid and its qualifications to perform the contract if its bid is accepted.
- 13.2 The documentary evidence of the Bidder's eligibility to bid shall establish to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) satisfaction that the Bidder, at the time of submission of its bid, is eligible as defined under ITB Clause 2.
- 13.3 The documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract if its bid is accepted shall establish to the (PCP) satisfaction:

- (a) that, in the case of a Bidder offering to supply goods under the contract which the Bidder did not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Bidder has been duly authorized by the goods' Manufacturer or producer to supply the in Pakistan;
- (b) that if a bidder is a firm / company or organization has a valid certificate from Govt. entity in respect of its registration / renewal.
- (c) That the Bidder has the financial, technical, and production capability necessary to perform the contract;
- (d) that, in the case of a Bidder not doing business within Pakistan, the Bidder is or will be (if awarded the contract) represented by an Agent in that country equipped, and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair, and spare parts-stocking obligations prescribed in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications if otherwise is not mentioned; and
- (e) That the Bidder meets the qualification criteria listed in the Bid Data Sheet.

14. DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING GOODS' ELIGIBILITY AND CONFORMITY TO BIDDING DOCUMENTS

- 14.1 Pursuant to ITB Clause 9, the Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the eligibility and conformity to the bidding documents of all goods and services which the Bidder proposes to supply under the contract.
- 14.2 The documentary evidence of the eligibility of the goods and services shall consist of a statement in the Price Schedule.
- 14.3 The documentary evidence of conformity of the goods and services to the bidding documents may be in the form of literature, drawings, and data, and shall consist of:
 - (a) a detailed description of the essential technical and performance characteristics of the goods;
- 14.4 The Bidder may substitute alternative standards, brand names, and/or catalogue numbers in its bid, provided that it demonstrates to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) satisfaction that the substitutions ensure substantial equivalence or higher to those designated in the Technical Specifications. In case if such brand /item /equipment has been abundant or ceased;

15. BID SECURITY

- 15.1 Pursuant to ITB Clause 9, the Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, a bid security in the amount specified in the Bid Data Sheet. [The bid security shall be submitted from the account of the firm/bidder/contractor who submits the bid].
- 15.2 The bid security shall be in Pak. Rupees as per bid data sheet or as required by PCP.
- 15.3 Unsuccessful bidders' bid security will be discharged or returned as promptly as possible the expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) pursuant to ITB Clause 16 as per KPPRA rules 2014.
- 15.4 The bid security is required to protect the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) against the risk of Bidder's conduct which would warrant the security's forfeiture under the followings:
 - (a) If a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form; or
 - (b) In the case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails:
 - i. To sign the contract in accordance with ITB Clause 32; or

- ii. To submit its bid in accordance with the conditions of knock out clause / basic requirement or in case of any false information or submission a fake document or in case of any illegal / fraudulent practice.

16. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS

- 16.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period specified in the Bid Data Sheet after the date of bid opening prescribed by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar, pursuant to ITB Clause 18. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) as nonresponsive.
- 16.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity as provided in KPPRA Rules 2014.

D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

17 SEALING/SIGNING AND MARKING OF BIDS

- 17.1 The Bidder shall upload the bid(s) on EPADS, with complete information as required.

18. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 18.1 Bids must be uploaded on EPADS, not later than the time and date specified in the uploaded Tender.
- 18.2 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for the submission of bids by amending the bidding documents in accordance with KPPRA Rules 2014.

19. LATE BIDS

- 19.1 Any bid received by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) after the deadline for submission of bids will not be accepted by EPADS.

20. WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

- 20.1 The Bidder may withdraw its bid after the bid's submission, through written declaration of withdrawal, is received by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), after opening of the bids.
- 20.2 The Bidder's withdrawal notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of ITB Clause 18. A withdrawal notice may also be sent by email, but followed by a signed confirmation copy, postmarked, after opening of the bids.

E. OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BIDS

21. PROCESS OF PROCUREMENT

- 21.1 Single Stage two envelop/process/ method provided in KPPRA Rules 2014 shall be followed if otherwise it is not mentioned.

22. OPENING OF BIDS BY THE PARAPLEGIC CENTER PESHAWAR

- 22.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will open all bids in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in

the Bid Data Sheet. The bidders' representatives who are present shall sign an attendance sheet evidencing their presence.

- 22.2 The bidders' names, bid prices, discounts, and the presence or absence of requisite bid security and such other details as the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), at its discretion, may consider appropriate, will be uploaded on EPDADS.

23. CLARIFICATION OF BIDS

- 23.1 During evaluation of the bids/prior the signing of the contract, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted.

24. PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

- 24.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will preliminarily examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 24.2 Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid will be rejected, and its bid security shall be forfeited. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail.
- 24.3 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may waive any minor informality, nonconformity, or irregularity in a bid which does not constitute a material deviation or change the substance of the bid, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.

25. QUALIFICATION & EVALUATION OF BIDS

- 25.1 In the absence of **prequalification**, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will determine to its satisfaction whether the Bidder is qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily, in accordance with the Evaluation Criteria / Section V.
- 25.2 The determination will take into account the Bidder's financial, technical, and production capabilities. It will be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to ITB Relevant Clause, as well as such other information, as the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) deems necessary and appropriate.
- 25.3 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will **technically evaluate** and compare the bids which have been determined to be substantially responsive, as per Technical Specifications requirement.
- 25.4 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will **financially evaluate** a bid on Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) standard and price shall be inclusive of all prevailing taxes and duties, if otherwise not mentioned.
- 25.5 PCP may consider a single bid if it is responsive as per KPPRA Rules 2014.
- 25.6 Financial evaluation bid shall be free from all computational errors.

26. ANNOUNCEMENT OF EVALUATION OF BIDS

- 26.1 PCP shall announce the evaluation report as provided in KPPRA Rules 2014 up dated.

27. CONTACTING THE PARAPLEGIC CENTER PESHAWAR

- 27.1 No Bidder shall contact the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time evaluation report is made public i.e. 10 days before the contract is awarded. If the Bidder wishes to bring additional information or has grievance to the notice of the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), it should do so in writing.
- 27.2 Any effort by a Bidder to influence the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) during bid evaluation, or bid comparison may result in the rejection of the Bidder's bid and forfeiting of its bid security and its blacklisting.

F. AWARD OF CONTRACT

28. AWARD CRITERIA

- 28.1 Subject to ITB Clause 30, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will award the contract to the successful Bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid as defined in KPPRA rules 2014.
- 28.2 In case if more than one bidder quotes the same cost / equal (lowest bid) the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may ask only to that lowest bidder at once to submit their financial bids again or opt any other option.

29. PARAPLEGIC CENTER PESHAWAR RIGHT TO VARY QUANTITIES AT TIME OF AWARD

- 29.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) reserves the right at the time of contract awarding to add/delete terms and conditions, the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions in accordance with prevailing rules & regulations.

30. PARAPLEGIC CENTER PESHAWAR RIGHT TO ACCEPT OR REJECT ALL BIDS

- 30.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) reserves the right to reject all bids, and to annul the bidding process at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the Bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the Bidder or bidders the grounds for the rejection of bids.

31. NOTIFICATION OF AWARD

- 31.1 Prior to the expiration of the bid validity period, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will notify the successful bidder in writing, either by registered letter or email, that their bid has been accepted, subject to the verification of the Bid Security. However, this acceptance shall not be considered a contract, and the bidder cannot make any claim or assert any vested right on this basis.
- 31.2 The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract subject to the Performance Guarantee.

32. SIGNING OF CONTRACT

- 32.1 After notifications to the successful Bidder that its bid has been accepted, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) will send the Bidder the Contract Form provided in the bidding documents or reviewed, incorporating all agreements between the parties but in accordance with KPPRA rules.
- 32.2 Within seven (07) days of receipt of the Contract Form, the successful Bidder shall sign and stamp the contract and return it to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP).
- 32.3 The stamp duty on the contract of the same shall be imposed as per the **“The Stamp Act, 1899”**.

33. COMMENCEMENT OF THE CONTRACT

- 33.1 The Contract shall be command after submission of the concerned Performance guarantee and its validation / conformation for the bank.

34. INTEGRITY PACT

- 34.1 PCP may require from the bidder (qualified) for submission of an integrity pact.

35. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES

- 35.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) requires that Bidders, Suppliers, and Contractors observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts. For the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth in KPPRA Rules /Act shall be applicable:
 - (a) The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will bar a firm, in accordance with prevailing Blacklisting procedures under KPPRA Rules 2014 in any case if deems so.
- 35.2 Furthermore, Bidders shall be aware of the provision stated in sub clause 5 and sub-clause 24 of the General Conditions of Contract.

36. GRIEVANCE REDRESSEL COMMITTEE

- 36.1 In case of any dis-satisfaction or objection against the evaluation/report, the agreed bidder may approach to the Grievance Redressal Committee that shall be notified by the CEO PCP for the purpose to address the grievance within 10 days after the announcement of the evaluation report as provided in KPPRA Rules 2014 amended. Single Stage two envelop/process/ method provided in KPPRA Rules 2014 shall be followed if otherwise it is not mentioned.

37. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

- 37.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract. If after thirty (30) days from the commencement of such informal negotiations
- 37.2 The matter shall be referred to Chief Executive Officer Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in case of Purchaser and supplier are not agreed or dispute is unsettled after 30days and shall decide the matter in accordance with prevailing laws after affording opportunity of hearing to the parties whose decision shall be final.
- 37.3 In case of any objection thereafter, the matter may be referred for judicature/arbitration in accordance with arbitration Act 1940.

Preparation and Submission of Bids

Mandatory Qualification Requirements.

Additional Requirements:

- g) A certificate from the dealer that all spare parts of the equipment to be supplied are easily available in Pakistan in the local market or from company owned outlets along with a certificate that its quoted price is not more than the price of market value.

 - f. The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) Notification of Award.
3. The Client may add, delete, review any conditions or clause of the contract with mutual consent of the subject without affecting the substance of the bid process.

SECTION-II

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this Contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- a) "The Contract" means the agreement entered into between the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) and the Supplier, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- b) "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the Supplier under the Contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations.
- c) "The Goods" means all of the equipment, machinery, and/or other materials which the Supplier is required to supply to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) under the Contract.
- d) "The Services" means those services ancillary to the supply of the Goods, such as transportation and insurance, and any other incidental services, such as installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training, and other such obligations of the Supplier covered under the Contract.
- e) The "KPPRA" Rules means the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Rules 2014 amended to date.
- f) "Province" means Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province.
- g) "GCC" means the General Conditions of Contract contained in this section.
- h) "The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)" means the organization purchasing the Goods.
- i) "Country" is Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- j) "The Supplier" means the individual or firm supplying the Goods and Services under this Contract.
- k) "Day" means calendar day.

2. APPLICATION

2.1. These General Conditions shall apply to the extent that they are not superseded by provisions of other parts of the Contract.

3. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN

- 3.1 For purposes of this Clause, "origin" means the place where the Goods were mined, grown, or produced, or from which the Services are supplied. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing, or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially recognized new product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.
- 3.2 The origin of Goods and Services is distinct from the nationality of the Supplier.

4. STANDARDS

4.1 The Goods supplied under this Contract shall conform to the standards mentioned in the Technical Specifications, and, when no applicable standard is mentioned, to the authoritative standards appropriate to the goods' country of origin. Such standards shall be the latest issued by the concerned institution.

5. USE OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION

- 5.1 The Supplier shall not, without the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) prior written consent, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample, or information furnished by or on behalf of the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the Supplier in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only as far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.
- 5.2 The Supplier shall not, without the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) prior written consent, make use of any document or information enumerated in GCC Clause 5.1 except for purposes of performing the Contract and under intimation of purchased.
- 5.3 Any document, specification, plan, drawing, pattern, or sample, other than the Contract itself, as enumerated in GCC Clause 5.1 shall remain the property of the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) and shall be returned (all copies) to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) on completion of the Supplier's performance under the Contract if so, required by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP).

6. PATENT RIGHTS

- 6.1 The Supplier shall indemnify the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the Goods or any part thereof.

7. INSPECTIONS AND TESTS

- 7.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) or its representative (the Head of Department) shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods its component / part to confirm their conformity to the Contract specifications at no extra cost to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP). The Technical Specifications shall specify what inspections and tests the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) requires and where they are to be conducted.
- 7.2 The inspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the Supplier, at point of delivery, and/or at the Goods' final destination. If conducted on the premises of the Supplier, all reasonable facilities and assistance, including access to drawings and production data, shall be furnished to the Head of Department at no charge to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP).
- 7.3 Any inspected or tested Goods if fail to conform to the Specifications, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may reject the Goods, and the Supplier shall either replace the rejected Goods or make alterations necessary to meet specification requirements free of cost to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may take any action against the supplier.
- 7.4 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the Goods/its components arrival in centre shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested, and passed by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) or its representative prior to supply from its source of origin.
- 7.5 Nothing in GCC Clause 8 shall in any way release the Supplier from any warranty or other obligations under this Contract.

8. PACKING

- 8.1 The Supplier shall provide such packing of the Goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination, as indicated in the Contract. The

packing shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit, and open storage. Packing case size and weights shall take into consideration, where appropriate, the remoteness of the Goods' final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.

- 8.2 The packing, marking, and documentation within and outside the packages shall comply strictly with such special requirements as shall be expressly provided for in the Contract, and in any subsequent instructions ordered by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar.

9. DELIVERY AND DOCUMENTS

- 9.1 Delivery of the Goods shall be made by the Supplier in accordance with the terms specified in the Schedule of Requirements. The details of Delivery and/or other documents to be furnished by the Supplier are specified in as per requirement of Purchaser.

10. TRANSPORTATIONS

- 10.1 The Supplier is required under the Contract to transport and offloading of the Goods to a specified place of destination within the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), (Store/Warehouse), shall be arranged by the Supplier, and related costs shall be included in the Contract Price.

11. INCIDENTAL SERVICES

- 11.1 The Supplier may be required to provide any or all of the following services, including additional services, or required by the Purchaser:
- (a) Performance or supervision of on-site assembly and/or start-up of the supplied Goods;
 - (b) Furnishing of tools required for assembly and/or maintenance of the supplied Goods;
 - (c) Furnishing of a detailed operations and maintenance manual for each appropriate unit of the supplied Goods;
 - (d) Performance or supervision or maintenance and/or repair of the supplied Goods, for a period of time agreed by the parties, provided that this service shall not relieve the Supplier of any warranty obligations under this Contract; and
 - (e) Training of the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) personnel, on-site, in assembly, start-up, operation, maintenance, and/or repair of the supplied Goods.
- 11.2 All cost for incidental service shall be borne by the supplier included in the contract Price for the goods and the purchaser shall not pay such cost in any case except additional requirement by the purchaser.

12. WARRANTY

- 12.1 The Supplier warrants that the Goods/ branded including all spare parts) supplied under the Contract are new, unused, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the Contract. The Supplier further warrants that all Goods supplied under this Contract shall have no defect, arising from design, materials, or workmanship (except when the design and/or material is required by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) specifications) or from any act or omission of the Supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied Goods in the conditions prevailing in the country of final destination.
- 12.2 This warranty shall remain valid for twelve (12) months for general raw material and components and 24 months or more for machinery, plant and equipment, as per OEM.

- 12.3 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.
- 12.4 Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, within the period of a week and with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof, without costs to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP).
- 12.5 If the Supplier, having been notified, fails to remedy the defect(s) within a reasonable period, they may proceed to take such remedial action as may be necessary, at the Supplier's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may have against the Supplier under the Contract.
- 12.6 In case of any default or failure to perform obligation as per contract, the supplier shall pay liquidated damages to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) with respect to the failure to meet the contractual guarantees. The rate of these liquidated damages shall be 0.1 % of the contract price per day. The maximum amount of liquidated damages for the whole of the goods may subject to satisfaction of Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), to be 5% of the contract price.

13. PAYMENT

- 13.1 The Supplier's request(s) for payment shall be made to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in writing, accompanied by an Invoice describing, as appropriate, the Goods Delivery Note and Inspection Report by the concerned department, and upon fulfillment of other obligations stipulated in the Contract.
- 13.2 The currency of payment is Pak. Rupees.

13. PRICES

- 13.1 Prices charged by the Supplier for Goods delivered and Services performed under the Contract shall not vary from the prices quoted by the Supplier in its bid.

14. CHANGE ORDERS

- 14.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may at any time, by a written order given to the Supplier, make changes within the general scope of the Contract in any one or more notwithstanding anything contrary to prevailing laws / rules.

15. ASSIGNMENT OR SUB -CONTRACT

- 15.1 The Supplier shall not assign, to any other or sublet or sub-contract with in whole or in part, its obligations to perform under this Contract, except with the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) are prior written consent.

16. DELAYS IN THE SUPPLIER'S PERFORMANCE

- 16.1 Delivery of the Goods and performance of Services shall be made by the Supplier in accordance with the time schedule prescribed by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in the Schedule of Requirements.
- 16.2 If at any time during performance of the Contract, the Supplier should encounter conditions impeding timely delivery of the Goods and performance of Services, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in writing of the fact of the delay, it's likely duration and its cause(s). As soon as practicable after receipt of the Supplier's notice, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) shall evaluate the situation and may at its discretion

extend the Supplier's time for performance, with or without liquidated damages, in which case the extension shall be ratified by the parties by amendment of Contract.

17. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

17.1 Notwithstanding anywhere in GCC Clause, if the Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Goods or to perform the Services within the period(s) specified in the Contract, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the Contract, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to the percentage (0.2 % of contractual price per day) of the delivered price of the delayed Goods or unperformed Services for each week or part thereof of delay until actual delivery or performance, up to a maximum.

18. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

18.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by written notice of default sent to the Supplier, may terminate this Contract in whole or in part:

- (a) if the Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Goods within the period(s) specified in the Contract, or within any extension thereof granted by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) pursuant to GCC relevant Clause or
- (b) If the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract.
- (c) If the Supplier, in the judgment of the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Contract. For the purpose of this clause: "Corrupt practice" means that defined in KPPRA Rules 2014 or Act amended to date.

18.2 In the event the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) terminates the Contract in whole or in part, the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, Goods or Services similar to those undelivered, and such additional costs shall be payable by the supplier. However, the Supplier shall continue performance of the Contract to the extent not terminated. The benefit of force majeure shall be in favour of client (PCP) if at any time.

19. FORCE MAJEURE

19.1 Notwithstanding anything contrary provided in the provisions of GCC Clauses, the Supplier shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages, or termination for default if and to the extent that it's delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.

19.2 For purposes of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in its sovereign capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freight embargoes.

19.3 If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in writing, the Supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event. The benefit of Force Majeure shall be in favor of client (PCP) if it happened anytime.

20. TERMINATION FOR INSOLVENCY

- 20.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) may at any time terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the Supplier if the Supplier becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent. In this event, termination will be without compensation to the Supplier, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP).

21. TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE

- 21.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP), by written notice sent to the Supplier, may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) convenience, the extent to which performance of the Supplier under the Contract is terminated, and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.
- 21.2 All enabling clauses of KPPRA laws / rules / regulations shall be strictly followed in the procurement and process and black listing contract management / proceedings.

22. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

- 22.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract, if after thirty (30) days from the commencement of such informal negotiations.
- 22.2 The matter shall be referred to Chief Executive Officer Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) in case of Purchaser and supplier are not agreed or dispute is unsettled after 30 days and shall decide the matter in accordance with prevailing laws after affording opportunity of hearing to the parties whose decision shall be final.

23. GOVERNING LANGUAGE

- 23.1 The Contract shall be written in the language English. The version of the Contract written in the specified language shall govern its interpretation. All correspondence and other documents pertaining to the Contract which are exchanged by the parties shall be written in the same language.

24. APPLICABLE LAW

- 24.1 The Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

25. NOTICES

- 25.1 Any notice given by one party to the other pursuant to this Contract shall be sent to the other party in writing or by fax or by email or any other modern devices (accepted by PCP) and confirm in writing to the other party's address, specified in the bidding document and construed its receiving if not responded.

26. TAXES AND DUTIES

- 26.1 Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fees, etc., incurred until delivery of the contracted Goods Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP).

27. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES

- 27.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) requires that Bidders, Suppliers, and Contractors observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts. For the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth in KPPRA Rules /Act shall be applicable:
- (a) The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP) will bar a firm/individual/ company/bidders/ contractors/suppliers/consultants/or what so ever named, in accordance with Blacklisting procedures under KPPRA Rules 2014 in any case if deems so.
- 27.2 Furthermore, Bidders shall be aware of the provision stated in the General Conditions of Contract.

28. PARAPLEGIC CENTER PESHAWAR PRIVILEGES

- 28.1 The Paraplegic Center Peshawar (PCP)) reserves the right at the time of contract awarding or thereafter to add/delete any terms and conditions, the quantity of goods and services originally specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions in accordance with prevailing rules & regulations.

29. INTEGRITY PACT

- 29.1 PCP may require from the bidder (qualified) for submission of an integrity pact.
